

**Changing traffic patterns through Fall 2015.
EXPECT MAJOR DELAYS or
Use I-695 or I-895 if traveling thru Baltimore City.**

Southbound I-95

- On or about Fri. **June 19**: Southbound I-95 traffic lanes will shift with all four lanes to the left from the Fort McHenry Tunnel to Hanover Street. The ramp from Key Highway to southbound I-95 will be closed 24/7 for about one month. The **detour route** will direct motorists to East McComas St., to Hanover St., to southbound I-95.



- On or about Sun. **June 28** for approx. 3-4 weeks: Southbound I-95 traffic lanes will split with three lanes to the left and one lane to the right. The on ramp from Washington Blvd. to I-95 southbound will also close.




NOTE: All dates and times are approximate and dependent on weather or other work related variables.

Northbound I-95

- On or about Tues. **July 7**: The left lane on northbound I-95 between Exit 50 (Caton Avenue) and Exit 52 (Russell Street) remains continuously closed (24/7). The remaining three northbound I-95 traffic lanes will split with two lanes to the left and one lane to the right in this area. Exit 51 (Washington Blvd.) will reopen and the detour will no longer be in effect. To use Exit 51, you **MUST** use the right lane prior to the split. To exit at Russell St, motorists should follow signs to use Exit 50 (Caton Avenue), keep left on the ramp, continue to northbound I-95, and exit at Russell St.



- On or about Sun. **June 21**: The ramp to Exit 55 (Key Hwy.) will be closed 24/7 for about three weeks. The detour route will direct motorists to Exit 54 (Hanover St.), to West Dickman St., to Cromwell St., to East McComas St., to Key Hwy.
Reminder: E-ZPass is accepted in all open toll lanes.



Commuters leaving Baltimore City should use Key Hwy. to enter northbound I-95 to help minimize delays.

Stay Alert So No One Gets Hurt!

- Seek alternate routes during peak travel periods (6-9 a.m.; 3-7 p.m.; Mon. - Fri.).
- Work-zone speed limits on northbound and southbound I-95 are reduced to **50 mph**.
- Work-zone safety speed cameras in use.
