



MAJOR TRAFFIC PATTERN CHANGES ON I-95 & I-395 IN BALTIMORE CITY



New traffic patterns accommodate ongoing roadwork Changes begin on or about May 30

Southbound I-95/I-395

- On or about Monday, **October 20 through approximately early November**: Southbound I-95 traffic will split immediately after the Fort McHenry Tunnel. If you want to exit at 55 (Key Highway) or 53 (I-395), you **MUST ENTER THE RIGHT TUNNEL**. If traveling through the **LEFT TUNNEL**, you will **NOT** be able to access exits 55 or 53. Exit 52 (295) will be accessible from all lanes.



Northbound I-95

- On or about **September 20 through mid-October**: Northbound I-95 traffic will split 3 lanes to the left, 1 lane to the right. Use the right lane **ONLY** for Exit 52 (Russell Street). Traffic in the right lane will be forced to exit at 53 (Downtown). Stay left to access Exit 53 (Downtown) and 55 (Key Highway). The on ramp from 295 northbound to I-95 Northbound will remain closed through Mid-October. The Hanover Street ramp will continue to be closed until Mid-October.



Stay Alert So No One Gets Hurt!

- Work zone safety speed cameras will be activated in June on Northbound I-95.
- Work zone speeds on Northbound and Southbound I-95 are **50 mph**.
- Reduce speeds through work zones, stay alert and seek alternate routes during heavily traveled periods (6-9 a.m.; 3-7 p.m.).
