

# Attention!

Construction work on I-95 may cause increased noise levels during day and overnight hours.

**The Maryland Transportation Authority (MDTA) is performing construction on the I-95 bridges between the Fort McHenry Tunnel and Caton Avenue (Exit 50).**

Upcoming work in your area includes overnight construction on the I-95 bridge and ramps adjacent to your community.

**Overnight work will be performed from 10:00 pm to 5:00 am and will include noise impacts to your community due to the removal and replacement of bridge joints. Louder than usual noise should be anticipated during the daytime and overnight. Daytime work will primarily occur during off peak hours (non-rush hours).**

Work is part of the MDTA's two-year project to remove and replace the existing concrete deck (riding) surface and roadway joints on mainline I-95 and the ramps serving I-95. Please note overnight work is necessary to ensure site access and lessen daily traffic impacts to motorists in your area.

The MDTA appreciates your patience as we continue to ensure safe and reliable travel throughout the I-95 corridor in Baltimore City.
