As part of the Maryland Transportation Authority's (MDTA) continuing efforts to preserve and maintain its facilities, work on the Millard E. Tydings Memorial Bridge (I-95 over the Susquehanna River) begins this fall, which includes installing new joints in the southbound roadway and other repairs.

**Lane closures permitted October 24, 2011,
through May 2012:**

Southbound I-95:

- Sundays at 9 p.m. through Fridays at 6 a.m. -- continuous single-lane closure. Two lanes will remain open.
- Sundays through Thursdays from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. the following morning -- double-lane closure. One lane will remain open.
- Periodic traffic drags may be in effect nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning to set barrier wall. During traffic drags, police will bring vehicles to a reduced pace prior to the work zone.

Northbound I-95:

- Mondays through Thursdays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. -- periodic single-lane closures.

NOTE: No lane closures will be permitted the day before, the day of and the day after major holidays.

Motorists should anticipate delays.
