


# PARK & RIDE STUDY

MdTA, in coordination with MTA, SHA, Harford County and Baltimore County, is conducting a Park & Ride Study servicing I-95 in Baltimore and Harford Counties. Preliminary findings indicate:



## MD 43 Park & Ride

- 755 existing spaces
- Currently provides transit services
- Will not be impacted by I-95 improvements
- Capacity meets existing and future needs



## MD 152 Park & Ride

- 209 existing spaces, 310 spaces with ongoing construction activity
- Will be impacted by Section 200 build alternates
- New Park & Ride will have approximately 325 spaces
- New Park & Ride will be transit accessible and include bike racks



## MD 24 Park & Ride

- Maintain existing 53 space Park & Ride south of I-95
- New Park & Ride to the north of I-95 will have approximately 200 spaces
- New Park & Ride will be transit accessible and include bike racks



## MD 543 Park & Ride

- 133 existing spaces
- Will not be impacted by I-95 improvements
- Capacity meets existing and future needs



## MD 22 Park & Ride

- 64 existing spaces
- Will not be impacted by I-95 improvements
- Capacity meets existing and future needs
