



## I-895 Roadway Rehabilitation from Toll Plaza to K-Truss Bridge

### Project Description:

A one-year, \$1.5 million project to perform roadway repairs along northbound and southbound I-895 between the Baltimore Harbor Tunnel (I-895) Toll Plaza and the K-Truss Bridge (just south of Exit 9, Childs Street). The project also includes rehabilitation of the bridge located east of Frankurst Avenue.

The project is scheduled to begin on or about Sept. 7, 2010, with completion expected by fall 2011.



### Traffic Impacts:

- One lane may be closed in each direction of I-895.
- Off-Peak closures and detours of Shell Road/southbound Frankurst Avenue (Exit 8A) and Hanover Street/northbound Frankurst Avenue (Exit 8B) entrance or exit ramps. Detour routes will be signed.
- Multiple toll-lane closures to allow efficient traffic flow approaching and exiting the work zone.
- Lane and ramp closures and detours may be in effect September through November 2010 and in spring 2011:
  - Monday through Thursday from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning
  - Continuously from Friday at 9 p.m. to Monday at 5 a.m.
  - Occasionally Monday through Thursday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and Friday from 9 a.m. to 12 noon.

Delays may occur, especially during extended weekend closures. Alternate routes to avoid delays are the Fort McHenry Tunnel (I-95) or the Francis Scott Key Bridge (I-695). No lane closures will be scheduled the day preceding, the day of, or the day following a major holiday.
