Canned meat, ham, tuna & chicken; peanut butter; pasta; fruits (canned or dried); canned soup, canned vegetables; evaporated and powdered milk; infant formula; breakfast cereal and oatmeal; rice; nuts and seeds; beans (canned or dried); paper goods; and plastic/paper cups and plates.
