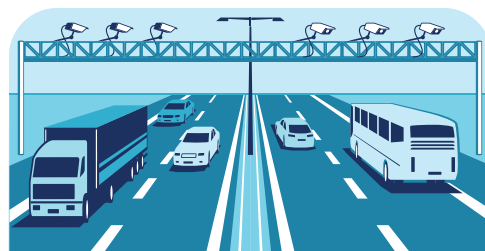
I-95 EXPRESS TOLL LANES

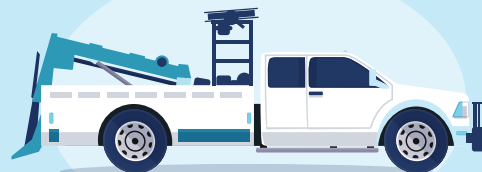

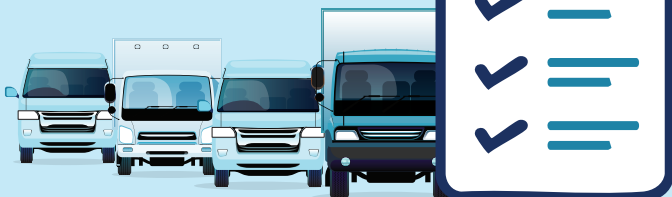
