

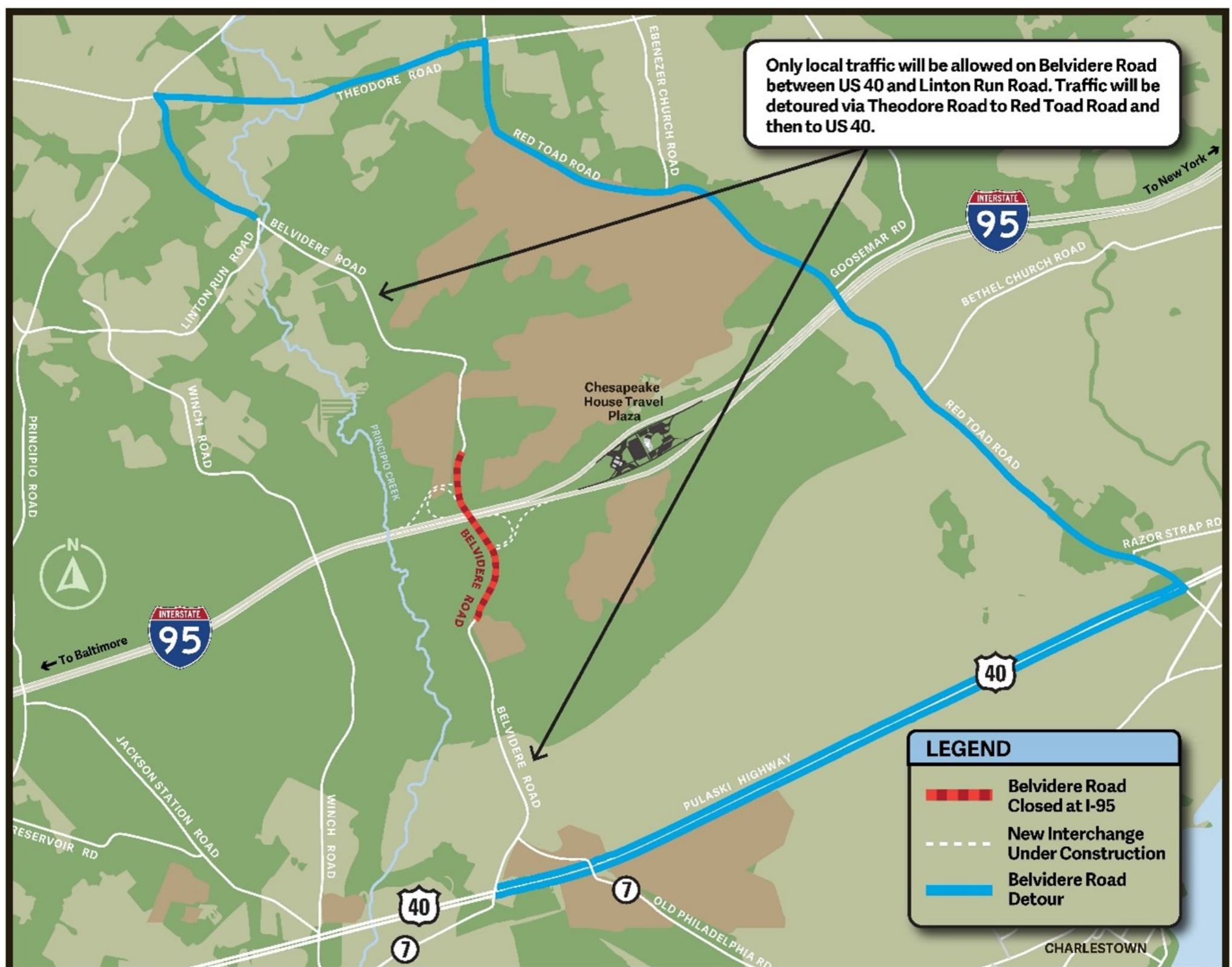


— TEMPORARY CLOSURE —

Belvidere Road Over I-95 on Consecutive Weekends Starting on Friday, October 3, 2025

In order to facilitate the ongoing construction of the new interchange at I-95 and Belvidere Road in Cecil County, it will be necessary to temporarily close Belvidere Road to through traffic on the weekends of October 3-5 and 10-12. Weather permitting, the closures will be in effect from Friday at 9 p.m. to Sunday at 5 p.m.

A detour will be in place to direct traffic around the closure via Red Toad Road:



Local access to private residences on Belvidere Road will be maintained throughout the closure.

The reconstruction of the Belvidere Road bridge over I-95 is part of a new interchange at I-95 and Belvidere Road that will accommodate future economic growth in the nearby Cecil County Enterprise Zone, provide more direct access to and from I-95 for trucks accessing the Zone, thereby reducing truck volumes on US 40, MD 222, and MD 272, and include environmental mitigation and reforestation measures.
